ORDER

UPON the Order of the Chair made following the fourth case management conference in the Proceedings on 9 and 10 January 2024 (the “Fourth CMC Order”)

AND UPON the parties having reached an agreement in respect of the Class Representative’s application as set out in a letter to the Tribunal dated 6 March 2024

AND HAVING REGARD TO the Tribunal’s powers under the Competition Appeal Tribunal Rules 2015

IT IS ORDERED BY CONSENT THAT:

1. Paragraph 17 of the Fourth CMC Order be amended to read as follows:

“The Defendant shall provide disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 13 and 15 above in the following tranches:

- (a) Subject to paragraph 18 below, the Defendant shall provide disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 13(a), (b), (f) and (g), and 15(c) above by 11 March 2024.
- (b) Subject to paragraph 18 below, the Defendant shall provide disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 13(d) above by 29 March 2024.
- (c) The Defendant shall provide disclosure pursuant to paragraphs 15(a)–(b) by 19 April 2024, save for any responsive documents from the additional agreed custodian, Mr David Wise, which will be provided by 26 April 2024.”

- 2. Costs in the case.
- 3. There be liberty to apply.
